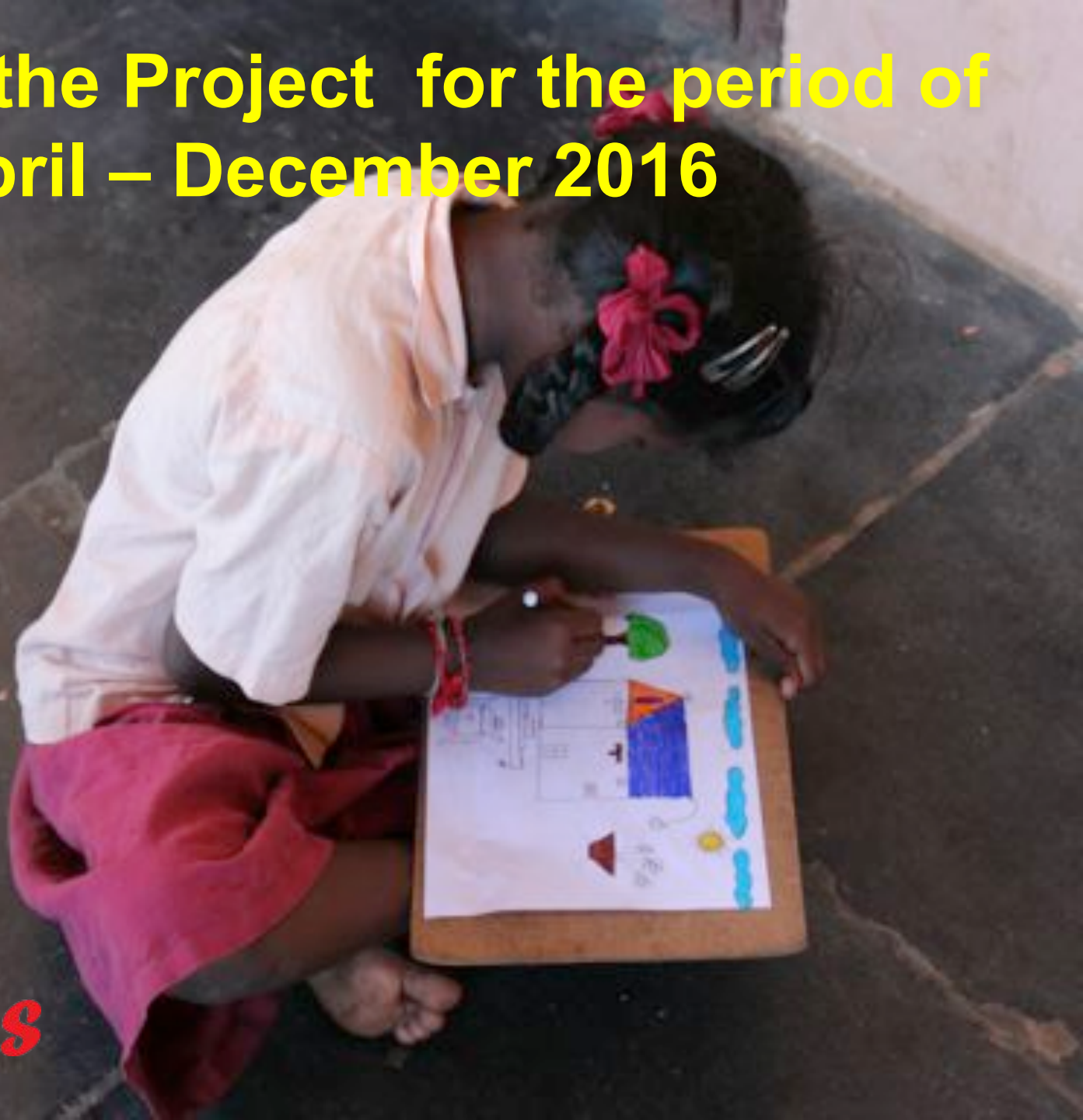

Reading Skill Enhancement Program (RSEP)

- ❖ **RSEP is Implemented in 5 Chennai Primary Schools (Magazipuram, Moorthingar, Sharma Nagar, Kannadhasan Nagar & Chinnandi Madam) in Vyasarpadi.**
- ❖ **We cover 909 students in Total, in which 466 were boys and 443 girl students.**
- ❖ **573 Children attend the program on regular basis.**
- ❖ **100 children showed high performance and moved to the next level.**
- ❖ **Children read 8 types of books includes Animals, Magic, Moral, Environment, Fairy tale, Adventure, Mixed and others.**
- ❖ **The children read 6499 books in total, in which 3240 books read by Boys and 3259 books by Girls.**

Declaration Event

❖ Under the School and Community supplementary Education Programme we cover totally 293 Children, in which 100 children from Schools and 193 Children from 12 supplementary Centres from 3 – 8 std covering in 6 areas.

❖ 179 Children from 5 schools were declared as readers in Tamil and issued Certificates.

❖ 245 children from 3 Chennai

❖ Corporation schools and 5 Community Supplementary were Declared in Maths (Addition, Division, Subtraction and multiplication).

❖ 55 children from 3-8 STD were declared as readers in English from Udayasooriyan Nagar and A&B Kalyanapuram.

❖ During the Initially evaluation the children had 20% skills and now they have attained 60% skills



School and Community Library

- ❖ **The School library is implemented in 5 Chennai Corporation schools in Vyasarpadi.**
- ❖ **Totally 155 (86 Boys & 69 Girls) Students are covered from 6-8 STD under this program.**
- ❖ **The books like short stories, novels, Great Leaders, Science, Magic and Moral Stories were distributed to children.**
- ❖ **Totally 1856 books were read by the students this year.**
- ❖ **Established 8 Reading Circle 16 operating areas. We have 240 readers from 8 circles.**

Early Childhood Care Development (ECCD)

- 41 young mothers and 20 children (Aged 0-6 yrs) were given awareness on Health and Hygiene under Early Childhood Care for Development (ECCD) project C. Kalyanapuram. Mrs. Karthika and Dhanusri facilitated the program. Program held in ICDS centre. Mrs. Chitra, Inspector, MKB Nagar spoke on women safety.



Important events - Education



• **Exposure Visit to Vandloor Zoo – April 2016**

90 community Children benefited from exposure visit to Vandloor Zoo. They got good opportunity to explore Nature, Birds and animals.

RSEP Summer Camp for children - April 2016

- ❖ 216 children participated in total, in which 114 were boys and 102 girls..
- ❖ Conducted Declaration event, Hand craft, games and songs.
- ❖ Program held in 5 Chennai Primary schools.

❖ **Supplementary Teachers training program – Nov 2016**

❖ The Supplementary Teachers training program held on 12 November 2016. 11 teachers participated, in which 4 teachers from 4-5 Std. 7 teachers from 6-8 Std.

❖ Meaningless sentences in Tamil, Multiplication and subtraction in Maths along with the training materials.

❖ Mr. Shankar and Mr. Sridhar from AID INDIA provided the training program

❖ Talent Quest Competition – November 2016

❖ The Talent Quest was conducted in 5 Schools. Totally 199 students, in which 88 boys and 111 girls participated in the program.

❖ 35 students were selected as winners.

❖ The Medal and Certificates were distributed to the children in the presence of Head Masters/ Mistress, Teachers and students in their own respective places.



❖ Activity based training for book fairies - December 2016

❖ 15 staff member participated in the program.

❖ Held at BSAC office on 21-22 December 2016

❖ Trained on short stories, songs, games and documentation.

Child Rights (Aarvam Children Movement)

- Created 20 Children sangam (Club) in 20 areas, in 5 clusters covering 640 children.
- Children are encouraged to participate in Club Meetings democratically taking decision, evaluate and implement their own activities.
- Children are actively participating in Cultural, Sports & Journalism
- To encourage child to Child process Young Facilitators team have trained and functioning
- Aarvam Children Movement Leaders are functioning their movement democratically and solving their local issues relating with Children.

➤ Leadership Camp – May 2016

- ❖ 40 children participated in the program
- ❖ The program held at Yelagiri hills.
- ❖ Camp was Federation election, J.J Act, POCSO act, Yearly Plan

➤ One Day Planning Camp – April 2016

- ❖ 331 children participated in the program
(169 boys & 162 Girls)
- ❖ Yearly Plan was prepared based on theme.

➤ Leaders Summer Camp May 2016

- ❖ 50 Children participated in the program.
- ❖ Program held for 10 days continuously
- ❖ Time management, Planning, Team building, Journalism, Dr. Ambedkar & Constitution India and hand Crafts , Self – esteem, leadership Quality and Organic food, Decision making.



Aarvam Child Rights Protection Policy framing

- ❖ 40 Children participated in the event.
- ❖ Mrs. Kirija Kamara Babu from ICCW facilitated the meeting.
- ❖ Aarvam Child Protection Policy was prepared.



Young Facilitators Training in April 2016

- ❖ 40 Students participated in the training program
- ❖ Discussed on Structure, Rights, Protection & Roles and Responsibilities
- ❖ Facilitated by Aarvam Staff members.

Drop out children school enrolment – June 2016

- ❖ 12 children were totally identified from 16 areas in Vyasarpadi
- ❖ 10 children were mainstreamed out of 12 children and remaining 2 children were joined in vocational institute.



French Volunteers Work Camp – July 2016

- ❖ Totally 60 children (30 from School and 30 from Community) participated in the Camp.
- ❖ During the training program Songs, Story creation, Handy Crafts, Drama and drawing were thought for the children.
- ❖ A Library in Kannadhasan Nagar School was renovated and inaugurated at the end of the camp.
- ❖ 120 people are benefited every day using the library in the school.



Independence day celebration in August 2016

- ❖ 249 children and 10 adults in total participated in the program.
- ❖ The program was particularly conducted to identify the blood group for the children



Sports Meet –August 2016

- ❖ 204 Children participated in the meet
- ❖ Conducted Koko , Carrum and football
- ❖ 82 people participated in the finals and 40 Children won the prizes. The Certificates and medals were distributed to the participants



Child Feast festival – September 2016

- ❖ 20 children participated
- ❖ Frog race, sack race, water filling, Running race.
- ❖ 13 children won the prizes.

❖ Joy of Giving Week – October 2016

❖ 148 Children participated in the event of Joy of giving week.

❖ The Children and staff actively participated in mobilizing the funds and raised (9615+13378) 22,993.

International Child Rights Day – 20th November 2016

- ❖ Children from Children Movement & supplementary centres participated in the program.
- ❖ quiz competition was conducted for the 24 children, 6 children each from 4 circle.
- ❖ The quiz was based on the Children rights and Acts related to children.
- ❖ Mr. Shanmugam, Director – Aarvam, Ms. Shalin – Researcher (History). Mr. Parameswaran – Treasurer – Aarvam presided over the event.
- ❖ The children gave the cultural program from each circle, like Folk Dance, Child Rights song, Para dance etc..



Koodivilaiyadu – December 2016

- ❖ 44 children in total participated in the event in which 26 are boys and 18 girls.
- ❖ The games conducted are Running, relay, shot foot long jump
- ❖ Children from 6 NGOs participated.
- ❖ Out of 6 NGOs, over all trophy won by Aarvam Children
- ❖ Aarvam children won 15 first prizes, 15 second prizes and 7 third prize.



Skill Building

Cultural Training for Children – December 2016

- ❖ 39 children from 4 circles participated, in which 20 girls and 19 boys.
- ❖ Mr. Isai Prakash facilitated the training.
- ❖ Parai dance and Street theatre was taught for the children.
- ❖ 24 children were selected and divided into two groups and formed as Parai Team and Street play team consist of 12 members in each group. The cultural training program held in Tonakela camp site in Ayyappakam, Chennai.
- ❖ The program was conducted from 28-30 December 2016



❖ **Adolescent Life Skill Psychology Empowerment Project – September and November 2016**

❖ 122 boys and girls from Circle I and II participated in the training program.

❖ Interpersonal Relationship, Effective Communication, Self – Analysis, Time Management and Team Building were the topics covered for them along with some games.

❖ Program Manager and coordinators facilitated the program.
